ÉPERNAY TO PARIS  
SPRING/SUMMER 2024

## OVERVIEW

With green hills lined with some of the world's most coveted grapevines and dotted with sprawling châteaux, France's Champagne region is the perfect destination for both oenophiles and Francophiles. Your cruise will begin in Épernay enjoying the fabulous and historic champagne houses of the region. As we make our way towards Paris, there will be many more opportunities to explore independent vineyards, WWI history sites, and the UNESCO heritage sites of Reims.



## DAY BY DAY

### Day 1: Épernay

- Get acclimated to life aboard Wonderland then stretch your legs along the Avenue de Champagne
- Afternoon: Enjoy a tasting at one of the renowned vineyards in the region
- Evening: Indulge in a delicious dinner in Épernay at Les Avisés, Le Thibault IV, or aboard Wonderland

### Day 2: Dormans

- Full Day Out: Embark on a vintage car ride around Reims or a hot air balloon tour above the vineyards while Wonderland cruises to Dormans
- Evening: Gourmet dinner aboard

### Day 3: Château-Thierry

- Morning: Cruise to Château-Thierry along the Marne River
- Afternoon: Tour the Champagne Cellars of the Château de Montmort
- Evening: Experience French cuisine at Le Jardin des Crayères

### Day 4: Charly Sur Marne

- Morning: Visit Château-Thierry Castle and the World War I American Monument
- Afternoon: Enjoy lunch out then perhaps play a round at Golf de Champagne while Wonderland cruises to Charly Sur Marne
- Evening: Enjoy dinner aboard or out: Les Magnolias or L'Auberge de la Brie

### Day 5: La Ferte Sous Jouarre

- Morning: cruise to La Ferte Sous Jouarre
- Afternoon: Cycle up to Abbey Jouarre and visit Musée de la Grande Guerre, showcasing WW I artifacts
- Dinner: Enjoy dinner aboard or on land

### Day 6: Meaux

- Morning: Cruise to Meaux, known for its historical sites
- Afternoon: enjoy a picnic out on the deck then explore the Meaux Cathedral and the Great War Museum
- Evening: Dine at a charming restaurant in Meaux

### Day 7: Lagny Sur Marne

- Morning: Cruise to Lagny-sur-Marne, a picturesque town
- Afternoon: Stroll through the town's historic streets
- Evening: Gourmet dinner aboard

### Day 8: Paris

- Morning: Cruise to Arsenal Marina or Canal L'Ourcq in Paris
- Afternoon: Disembark and transfer to Paris for your onward journey
